
Adolescent Program

The Program at Kaiser Foundation Rehabilitation Center is an individualized, outcome-driven and integrated program that addresses the complicated needs of adolescents (14-17 years old). Our program focuses on preventing further impairment and reducing disability to promote an optimal quality of life for our members. Our goal is to achieve functional outcomes focused on home and community integration and enhancement of self worth and engagement in productive activities. We served 12 adolescents in 2023 with an average age of 16. The average number of days our patients stayed in the inpatient acute rehabilitation program was 15 days, average CARE Mobility gain was 33, CARE Self-Care gain was 11.4 and average onset was 29 days.

100% of our adolescent patients surveyed reported that they were satisfied or very satisfied after their stay at Kaiser Foundation Rehabilitation Center in 2023
