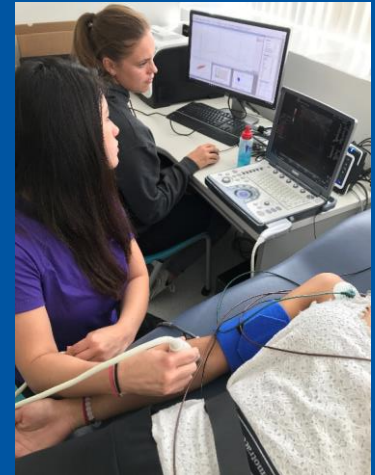

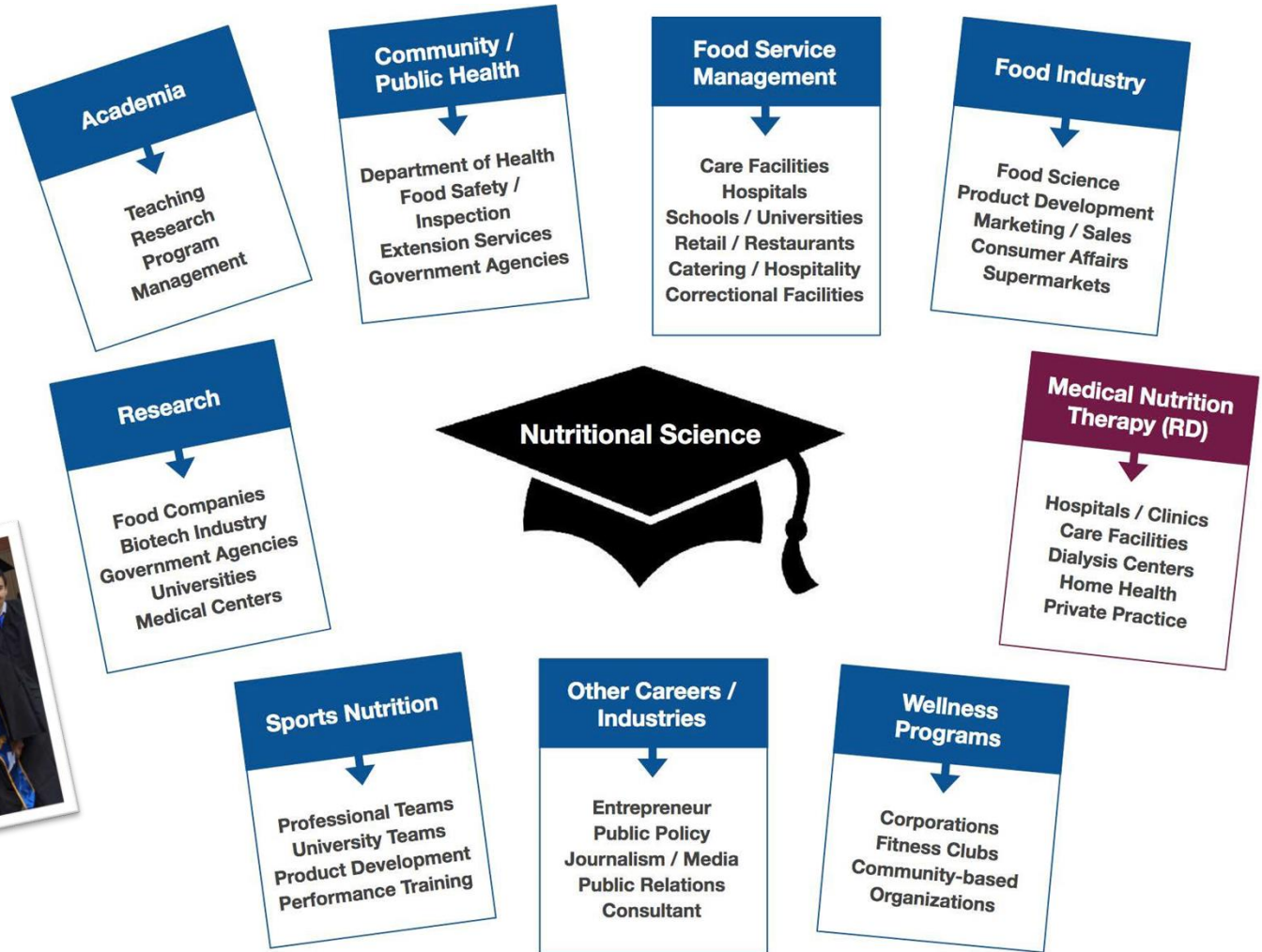

# Recreation

The Bachelor's degree in Recreation is comprised of a core set of classes and courses split generally between concentration courses and major electives. Graduates completing one of these concentrations are eligible to apply for national and state certification.

# Occupational Therapy

The Master of Science in Occupational Therapy program is designed for students who have earned a baccalaureate degree in a discipline other than occupational therapy. It enables the student to obtain the education and degrees necessary to be eligible to practice as an occupational therapist. Once the Master of Science degree in occupational therapy is completed including successful completion of the required 6 months of fieldwork, the student is eligible to sit for the national certification examination. Successful completion of the examination qualifies the candidate to apply for national certification and state licensure. The Occupational Therapy Department will welcome the first cohort of students for the Occupational Therapy Doctorate (OTD) degree in Spring of 2023.

The Department of Audiology at San Jose State University will offer the Doctor of Audiology (AuD) degree program beginning in Fall 2020. Our program is a 4-year course of study that includes academic courses, clinical rotations, and a doctoral research project (110 units total). The faculty is committed to student success. Class sizes are small to facilitate faculty-student interaction. AuD students will work with graduate students in other healthcare fields to provide coordinated care and support to children and adults with hearing loss. Our off-campus clinical rotations will take place in a variety of public and private clinical settings to allow students to train under experienced audiologists in our community.
