Kaiser Permanente to Open New Target Clinics in Menifee and Norco

**High-Quality, Affordable Care Will be Offered to
Kaiser Permanente Members and Non-Members**

RIVERSIDE, Oct. 15, 2019 – Kaiser Permanente, the nation’s largest integrated health system, and Target Corp. will open two new Kaiser Permanente-staffed retail health clinics in Menifee and Norco that will offer convenient care to members and non-members.

The new Target Clinics are located at 30340 Haun Road in Menifee; and at 1290 Hamner Ave. in Norco. They are scheduled to open on Monday, Oct. 21. Patients can schedule an appointment online at kptargetclinic.org or walk-in when there is availability.

“These new Target Clinics are part of Kaiser Permanente’s commitment to expanding access to high-quality care in Riverside County, and we’re excited about our continued collaborative effort with Target Corp.,” said Vita Willett, senior vice president of the Kaiser Permanente Riverside County Service Area. “We know residents want options when it comes to their health care needs, and Target Clinics provide quality services by trained medical clinicians in a convenient and safe setting.”

There will now be five Target Clinics affiliated with Kaiser Permanente serving residents in Riverside County, and 23 across Southern California. Other Target Clinics in Riverside County are located in Hemet (3527 W. Florida Ave.), Riverside Arlington (333 Arlington Ave.) and Palm Desert (72549 Highway 111). The clinics are all inside Target stores.

All Target Clinics are open from 9 a.m. until 7 p.m. Monday through Friday, and from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. on weekends. The clinics are closed daily from 2 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.

“We look forward to providing expedient first-class health care services to the Menifee and Norco communities as part of our commitment to serving residents across Riverside County,” Willett said.

The Target Clinics will offer a wide variety of health services including flu shots, physicals, allergy relief, TB tests and wellness check-ups for children and adults. Also offered will be basic dermatology services, as well as vaccinations and treatment for some illnesses including strep throat, sinus pain, ear aches, asthma and cold and flu.

Kaiser Permanente will staff the new clinics with courteous medical professionals that include licensed nurse practitioners and licensed vocational nurses. The clinics will also have physicians available via telemedicine consultations, giving Target guests and members of the community additional access to Kaiser Permanente's high-quality and affordable health care services.

Target Clinics accept a broad range of health insurance plans, as well as major credit, debit and Health Savings Account cards.
