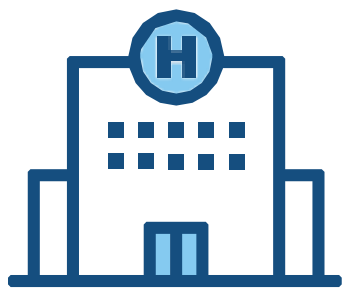


# VISITOR POLICY

Facilities in counties with  
**Substantial COVID-19 transmission rates**

## Visitation Restricted



### **Hospital and Emergency Department**

**1 VISITOR AT A TIME, with EXCEPTIONS of up to 2 visitors for:**

- Pediatrics, NICU or PICU
- Labor & Delivery (including prearranged doula)
- Hospice or end of life
- Patients with disabilities (physical, intellectual, cognitive impairments and/or developmental disabilities)



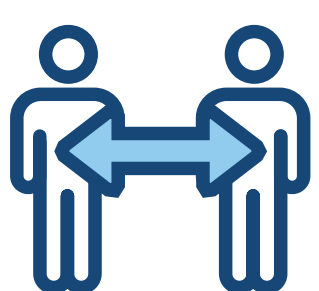
### **Medical Office/Clinic**

**UP TO 2 SUPPORT PERSONS in the exam room\* for:**

- Pediatric patients (2 adults if multiple children have appointments)
- Patients with disabilities, language\*\* or emotional support needs

*\*Visitors not with the patient in the exam room must wait outside the building*

*\*\*If language line cannot support*



### **General Visitor Guidelines and Safety Precautions:**

- Symptom screening of all visitors
- No visitors with COVID-19 symptoms or suspected COVID-19 allowed
- Maintain masking, 6 feet social distancing, and hand washing
- Follow instructions from staff
- Visitors should limit movement in the facility
- No eating or drinking in patients' rooms
- Visitors under 18 must be accompanied by an adult
- Consider asking if a virtual visit is possible



### **MASKS REQUIRED, even if you are vaccinated**

- Masks must cover your nose, mouth and chin
- Patients must continue to wear a mask in exam rooms
  - unless told to remove it by staff
