

VISITOR POLICY



Hospital/Inpatient

- All patients will be allowed up to 2 visitors at the same time.
 - If physical distancing cannot be accomplished, then 1 visitor is allowed at a time.
- Hospital visitors will be asked to provide proof of full vaccination and/or negative COVID-19 test.
- Certain exemptions may apply for the following:
 - Pediatric patients
 - Labor and Delivery patients
 - Patients at End-of-Life
 - Patients with physical, intellectual, and/or developmental disabilities (including cognitive impairments)



Medical Office/Clinic

- 1-2 person(s) may accompany any patient into the exam room depending on the ability to maintain 6 feet social distancing.

General Visitor Guidelines:



- All visitors will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms.
- No visitor with COVID-19 symptoms may enter.



- Visitors must wear a well-fitting mask over your nose and mouth while on the premises.



- Maintain 6 feet physical distancing from health care workers and other patients/residents/visitors that are not part of their group while present in the hospital.

Exceptions to our visiting policy, including further limiting visitation, may be made at the discretion of your caregiver, based upon your condition and need for visitation.
