**Boys & Girls Club of Santa Clarita Valley** received funding to encourage low income youth in the Santa Clarita Valley to adopt healthy lifestyles through their half hour hustle after school program, provision of healthy snacks, cooking classes, and team and recreational sports.

**Bridge to Home** received funding to provide housing navigation and case management for homeless individuals in the Santa Clarita Valley helping to secure transitional and permanent housing with access to benefits, resources, and support services.

**Carousel Ranch** received funding to provide equestrian therapy and physical exercise for children with special needs who are at risk of obesity resulting from a sedentary lifestyle.

**Child & Family Center** received funding to provide school based mental health support and counseling for children showing early signs of behavioral health problems in elementary school.

**Samuel Dixon Family Health Center** received funding to provide a diabetes prevention program including nutrition education and clinical monitoring for low income uninsured and underinsured diabetic patients in the Santa Clarita Valley.

**Santa Clarita Valley Senior Center** received funding to provide expanded case management, health & wellness programming, and screenings to low income seniors at a new Senior Center in the Santa Clarita Valley.

**Santa Clarita Valley Youth Project** received funding to provide access to campus based mental health services such as support groups and peer counseling for at risk junior and high school students in the Santa Clarita Valley.

**Single Mother's Outreach** received funding to provide family case management and coordination of social services and mental health services for low income single parents and children in the Santa Clarita Valley.



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
