Baldwin Hills – Crenshaw Medical Offices

Located on the corner of Marlton Avenue and Santa Rosalia Drive in the Marlton Square complex, the Baldwin Hills - Crenshaw Medical Offices will bring convenient access to high-quality primary and specialty care services for members who live and work in the Crenshaw community.

This facility will be a cutting-edge, four-story medical office building complete with LEED Gold certification. Approximately 60 world class providers will treat our Baldwin Hills - Crenshaw members in technologically advanced exam rooms, equipped with the ability to conduct real time virtual consults with other Kaiser Permanente providers throughout the region.

As a part of our commitment to building healthy communities, our design for the 100,000-square-foot building includes a conference room and outdoor event space that will be available to local community groups. We will also incorporate 2.5 acres of “green” space, including a contiguous, two-mile walk path.

The Baldwin Hills - Crenshaw Medical Offices will be a part of the West Los Angeles Medical Center Service Area, which includes nearly 220,000 members. The Baldwin Hills – Crenshaw Medical Offices will serve over 50,000 members in this neighborhood.

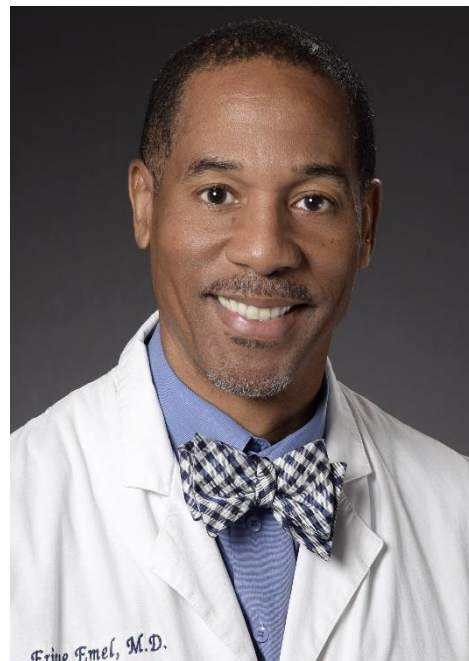
