

Kaiser Permanente Southern California to resume allergy shot treatments

Recently, the National Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommended that all non-urgent procedures be postponed due to the presence of the COVID-19 virus.

We are concerned about your safety and want to assure you we are doing everything we can to keep you safe and healthy. As the situation is rapidly evolving, we will provide timely updates through secure messages.

Effective immediately, we are postponing all allergy shot treatments. We anticipate that allergy shot patients will need to wait at least one month before making their next allergy shot treatment visit. That timeframe may be extended based on recommendations from the CDC.

We realize that postponing your allergy shots may be disappointing for you, but this is an unprecedented situation and your safety is our number one priority. Your Allergy doctor will work with you to resume your allergy shot treatments safely at the appropriate time.
